Wisconsin native to make Broadway debut in "Good Night, and Good Luck" starring George Clooney

Madison, Wis. (Feb. 26, 2025) — Wisconsin native **Sophia Tzougros** is making her Broadway debut on Wednesday, March 12 in "Good Night, and Good Luck" starring two-time Academy Award® winner George Clooney. Clooney is also making his Broadway debut in the electrifying stage adaptation of the critically acclaimed film.

Tzougros attended Kettle Moraine School for Arts and Performance in Wales, Wis., and participated in Overture Center's Jerry Awards, one of Wisconsin's high school musical awards programs that encourages, recognizes and honors excellence in high school musical theater. In 2014, she was selected to represent Overture Center at the National High School Musical Theatre Awards®, also known as the Jimmy Awards®, with other high school students from across the country. Although many students from

Overture's Jerry Awards have gone on to professional careers in the arts and to perform in Broadway tours, Tzougros is the first participant to be cast in a Broadway production in New York City.

Under the direction of Tony Award®-winner David Cromer, from the original screenwriters Clooney and Grant Heslov, "Good Night, and Good Luck" chronicles a time in American history when truth and journalistic integrity stood up to fearmongering and disinformation—and won. This strictly limited engagement begins with its first performance on **Wednesday, March 12 at the Winter Garden Theatre** in New York City and runs through Sunday, June 8, 2025.
