Madison, Wis. (Dec. 23, 2024) – Kick off the new year with a dive into the heart of the Edinburgh Fringe Festival! Overture Center is hosting a three-day mini festival showcasing five electrifying acts from the 2023 Edinburgh Fringe Festival, the world's largest arts festival. Overture's Fringe Festival will run from Friday, Jan. 10 through Sunday, Jan. 12 and include cutting-edge theater, side-splitting comedy, mesmerizing drag and jaw-dropping cirque acts.
